

SSAA NSW H&C 2012 TILTERWEIRA Family Week

**Mum and Dad this is an opportunity to share
Easter hunting experience with the family.**

The SSAA NSW property of 80,000 acres near Wanaaring has been set aside for family activities for one week in the Easter school holiday period.

Family groups are to be self contained. (providing for family needs)

SSAA NSW H&C Program will have an instructor available to assist with the following workshops:

- * **SSAA Hunting and Conservation Course accreditation.** This course is recognised by all SSAA H&C Groups in Australia. It will allow you to travel interstate and participate in programmed Feral Pest management projects.
- * **NSW Game Council R Licence accreditation:** R Licences give you permission to hunt on selected parcels of public land
- * **UHF radio use for field activities for communication.**

Tilterweira Station facilities : Licenced Range facilities allowing shotgun, rifle and pistol shooting.
: Large Camp Kitchen - Gas Stove, Fuel Stove, Microwave Oven and BBQ
: Large Cool room with adequate space for perishables, Camp refrigeration
: Cray fishing, swimming in the Paroo River, photography and bush walks
: Guided hunting on request.

Tilterweira station is not licenced so participants must supply their own alcoholic beverages.

Responsible use of alcohol rules apply.

All participants who are going to handle firearms are required to have a current NSW Shooters Licence or Junior permit issued by NSW Firearms Registry or other states authority.

Minimum Caliber for hunting pigs and goats on Tilterweira Station - 6mm or .243

NOTE: The handling of firearms is not permitted by unlicenced persons — *NSW Police Firearms Act 1996*

Other hunting opportunities will be made available where participants may participate in a guided hunt on a neighboring property. **Additional charges for this activity will apply**
