**Have you ever wanted to learn the skill of hunting
and never had the chance?**

**SSAA NSW offers shooter this opportunity. Spend a week with
experienced hunter and enjoy the hunting experience taking
game and preparing it for trophy or domestic use.**

Limited to 12 applicants; book early and avoid disappointment

The course is one week at SSAA NSW's own 80,000 acre property of Tilterweira Station near Wanaaring. This property offers the opportunity for hunters to experience different Western NSW Hunting environments:

- * *River overflows lignum which is an ideal location for pigs,*
- * *Sandy creek and Mulga country where goats and pigs are often found*
- * *Stony country which provides a shelter and a browsing habitat for goats.*

Daily workshops program provide experiences that allow you to:

- * complete the SSAA Hunting and Conservation Course accreditation. This course is recognised by all SSAA H&C Groups in Australia. It will allow you to travel interstate and participate in SSAA programmed Feral Pest management projects.
- * complete NSW Game Council R Licence accreditation: R Licences give you permission to hunt on selected parcels of public land
- * how to book an R licence hunt and scout a forest for game
- * use of a UHF radio during field activities for communication
- * GPS as a mapping and location device in the field.
- * sharpen a knife and value a quality hunting knife
- * prepare game meat for camp use
- * cook an evening meal using a camp oven.
- * track and understand animal behavior, and improve your hunting skills.

Participant will be provided with four guided hunts for the week and have the opportunity to take one trophy goat and one goat for the camp kitchen — unlimited Pigs, Foxes and Rabbits. At the conclusion of the course all participants will have the opportunity to take an unguided hunting trip on Tilterweira Station.

All meals are provided. Participants will be asked to help out with the daily camp functioning to assist the volunteer staff make the experience worthwhile for all.

Tilterweira station is not licenced so participants must supply their own alcoholic beverages. Tilterweira has a large cool room and space is available.

Responsible use of alcohol rules apply.

All participants are required to have a current Firearms Licence
Accommodation is shared at the property's well maintained shearer's quarters

Minimum Caliber for hunting pigs and goats on Tilterweira 6mm or .243
