OBTAINING THE R-LICENCE

SSAA members are able to complete the SSAA NSW Hunting & Conservation R Licence Accreditation Course for Firearms, Black powder and Dogs by correspondence.

The booklet developed by SSAA Training provides the information required to complete the Game Council NSW approved test.

The modules required to obtain an R-Licence are:

1. NSW Legislation
2. Hunter Ethics
3. Firearms Handling
4. Optional - Muzzleloading Longarms and Dogs

These modules are in the booklet together with question and answer sheets. Successful completion of these questions entitles you to a certificate, which when accompanied by an application form allows you to apply to the Game Council for an R Licence.

The booklet is free, however a marking fee will apply to submitted tests.

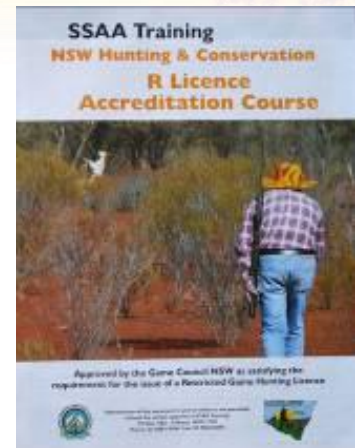
Participants of the SSAA NSW Hunting & Conservation Program do not incur a fee.
