

STAYING AT TILTERWEIRA: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All bookings must be accompanied by a 50% deposit. Payment can be made with cheque, credit card, money order or cash.
- The deposit – less a 20% handling fee to cover administration costs – will be returned upon cancellation of your booking.
- If your booking is postponed, the full deposit will transfer to your new booking.
- A booking form must be completed by each and every visitor to Tilterweira Station.
- Participants of the SSAA NSW Hunting & Conservation Program are entitled to a 10% discount on accommodation fees only.

■ ALL VISITORS MUST REPORT TO THE PROPERTY MANAGER UPON ARRIVAL AT TILTERWEIRA.

- Visitors to Tilterweira Station must at all times abide by the directions given by the Property Manager.

■ FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE TERMS & CONDITIONS MAY RESULT IN THE RESTRICTIONS OR CANCELLATION OF HUNTING ACTIVITIES.

- When two or more groups of visitors are on the property hunting, block allocations will be made by the Property Manager.

■ NO HUNTING OR SHOOTING IS PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE ALLOCATED TRACKS.

- Vehicles must remain on formed roads and tracks.
- The speed limit on the property is 60km/h. Around the Homestead the speed limit is 20km/h.
- Visitors must hunt or travel around the property in groups of at least two people.

■ BEFORE LEAVING CAMP, THE LOCATION OF ALL DAILY ACTIVITIES IS TO BE PLACED ON THE BLACKBOARD MAP OF THE PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE SHEARER'S QUARTERS.

- The Property Manger should be advised of all intended movements on or off the property.
- A good quality UHF radio or satellite phone is recommended.
- Tilterweira Station uses channel 40 and most locations on the property can be reached with a vehicle based 5 watt receiver.
- Only visitors with a Firearms Licence may use and handle firearms.
- All firearms are to be cleaned at the range.
- Firearms are to be stored in accordance with NSW Police Firearms Registry requirements. There are secured firearm lockers provided in each room.
- All hunting is to be conducted on foot, No shooting is permitted from vehicles.
- All carcasses are to be field dressed. Gutting is not permitted in the meat house.
- Trophy heads are not to be cleaned or stored in the meat house.
- Spotlight shooting is permitted, however there is NO spotlighting of goats.
- Camels are to be approached with caution.

■ NO SHOOTING OF CAMELS, KANGAROOS OR ANY OTHER NATIVE SPECIES.

- The sighting in of firearms is to take place only on the NSW Police Firearms Registry approved range.

- Care is to be taken when shooting near property boundaries. No shooting over boundary fences and onto neighboring properties.
- Shearers quarters, meat house and camp sites are to be left in a neat and tidy condition.
- Rubbish is to be placed in the bins provided.
- The minimum caliber for hunting goats and pigs is 6mm – 243.
- There are no limits on the amount of pigs, foxes, cats, hares or rabbits culled.
- There is a limit of one Trophy goat and two goats, used for meat, per hunter permitted.
- NSW fishing laws apply to catching yabbies & fishermen must have a NSW Fishing Licence.
